

## Welfare Reform Impact Analysis

Local authorities need to understand what impact welfare reform policies are having on each of their residents. Yet the impacts of reforms are complex, confusing and change over time. We help councils and others to understand the impact of all policy changes on each individual household.

Using the local authority's own household level data our person-centred approach enables better targeting of scarce support resources to where it's most needed.

We use your household level data and our software to create rich insights showing how individual households in your area are affected by cumulative and aggregate welfare reforms.

- Plan now to mitigate against negative impacts on individual households



### Every household counts

Your data can tell you that "Mrs Jones at 73 High Street will lose £15.62 per week due to all welfare changes, and she has high barriers to work".

We can show which of your individual households are affected by current and future welfare reforms, and by how much, and we provide indicators to help you target support. Knowing this information for each of your residents can help you to make stronger strategic and operational decisions, now and in the future.

You can proactively use the insights to engage residents before they run into financial hardship.



## Rich data about each household

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Local authorities have to analyse the impact that policies will have on their residents. Typically the impact of each policy is analysed in aggregate, and in isolation. Because of the way policies interact, and have knock on effects, it can be very difficult to model all policy changes together.

We take your household level data and show you the impact of all reforms from the perspective of your residents. This resident-centred approach helps you to take proactive decisions about how to target support. You can see the cumulative impact of current welfare reforms, plan to mitigate the effect of future welfare reforms, and understand the barriers to work faced by each household.

### Additional big data services available

1. Visualisation of analysis using heat maps
2. Design of a tailored CTRS or other local support scheme
3. Combine with other data sets, e.g. arrears data, discretionary housing payments, health data
4. Analysis on a subset of residents (e.g. all residents living in council accommodation)
5. Longitudinal analysis to track a customer's journey with your local authority
